It is true that good housing leads to a healthier life. In October 2015, I established the Māori Housing Network to support the housing needs and aspiration of whānau. Since that time, Te Puni Kōkiri has become the first port-of-call for Māori housing. However there are also significant funds and services in other Government departments.

This booklet provides a guide to the range of housing services and funds available across the Government sector. I hope you find this resource valuable in helping your housing needs and aspirations.

This guide provides information about services and support available from Te Puni Kōkiri and other government agencies.

Te Puni Kökiri supports whānau, hapū and iwi Māori to achieve their housing aspirations



For Māori housing ideas, the first step is to contact your Te Puni Kōkiri regional office and talk to one of our advisors

Contact your regional office for advice on:

- Repairs to homes in your community
 - We can give you advice and possibly a grant to support community coordinated housing repair programmes.
- Building on Māori land
 - Some limited funding is available to help ropū build new affordable rental homes for whānau (eg papakāinga).
- Another housing idea you want to develop into a proposal
 - Your idea may fit with the Māori Housing Network's funding priorities.

The process

- Your regional adviser will help you plan your project and identify the potential for your project to receive support. If your project is eligible the adviser will explain how to prepare a funding proposal.
- Once submitted, your proposal will be considered alongside other proposals.
 We have a limited putea and cannot fund every project that comes to us.
- If your proposal is approved we will work with you on the next steps which will include developing a funding agreement as well as explaining the regular reporting you will need to do.

We may be able to help with information, advice and referrals to other agencies and sources of funding.


